

**Linda Anneveld** is an all-round theatre maker and artistic director of Compagnie DaaD.

She was educated at the HKU (College for the Arts, Utrecht) and has worked in the field of outdoor theatre for over 22 years.

**Compagnie DaaD's** work is a crossover between visual arts and theatre. A strong image is the first thing the audience sees. It is used as a bridge to reach the public.

Their theatrical language can best be described as non-verbal, visual and physical. The great attention to stage imagery, the passion, care and craftsmanship with which sets, costumes and props are designed and produced are what makes DaaD stand out. In addition, technology plays an important role in their productions.

The projects have a nostalgic, absurd, funfair-like atmosphere that is decorated with elements from the grand guignol and the slapstick. But they are also fragile, confrontational and poetic. This (apparent) contradiction creates a theatrical tension that gives each production of DaaD its very unique signature.

# Theatre performance BOAT

**BOAT** a visual and poetic cartoon.

A moving theatre spectacle balancing between imagination and reality.

### **General**

BOAT starts as a circle performance. During the performance, the boat will drive slowly and stop 3 times in a spacious place to play a scene. The audience follows along like a turbulent sea.

### Location

We need a paved surface: a square, a street or a park, free of trees, obstacles and hills. The distance covered by BOAT is 250 to 500 meters long, min. 8m wide with 3 spacious areas for the public.

#### Set

BOAT is 3m long, 3m wide and 2m high, passage width 1.5 m. BOAT is a bicycle with a boat on springs, resting on the structure.

**Audience** All ages and nationalities (200+)

**Length** 30 minutes, 2 performances per day

**Team** Two persons **Language** Non-verbal

**BOAT** is about the ups and downs of two fishermen.

During their search for fish, the fish wives 'Greet and Griet' have to deal with all kinds of problems that you can expect at sea.

To prevent the two sisters from ending up between ship and shore, they literally have to row with their oars and pull out all the stops.


A story in which recognisable images are reversed and shaken up with a good dose of humour.

## **General**

Visitors wait at the Buzzz stop, where the counter is located to get a Buzzz ticket. Accompanied by the conductors, visitors can take place on the go-karts and a course is taken together.

## Location

The course is max. 150m long, min. 3m wide, on a square, a street or in a park. We need a paved surface free of trees, obstacles and hills.

## Set

5 go-karts, span 2.5m, height 2m.

2 conductors, 1 ticket counter and 3 Buzzz stops.

Audience Children from 4 years old

**Length** 2 x 90 minutes **Team** Two persons

Language Dutch, English and German

With a special Buzzz service, and under the supervision of two conductors, you travel from stop to stop where passengers can get on and off the wonderful flying machines.

For a ticket and clear instructions, travellers can contact the skilled chief conductor. A dreamy assistant provides the chief with a pair of extra eyes to keep everything safe.

And you, as a visitor, can operate these giant insects yourself!

**Buzzz** is a theatrical interactive experience for the smaller, and a visual parade for the larger persons among us.

## Theatrical installation Witte Wieven

### General

The installation is set in motion by the wind.

## Location

A square, a street or a park with a flat hard surface. Free from trees, hills and obstacles.

#### Set

The installation consists of 7 tumblers, arranged in a circular shape. The height of the figures varies from 1.7 meters to 2.3 meters. Total installation surface 5 x 5 meters.

Theatrical installation Witte Wieven

Dancing women appear in a fog bank and tempt you to come with them. But once in the fog, there is no turning back. The installation is an adaptation on the myth **Witte Wieven**.

The installation shows seven female figures in different phases of their lives. Life can be erratic and unexpected. This unpredictability is represented by the group of women who are set in motion by the wind: a field of tension, balancing to the edge, falling and standing up again.
